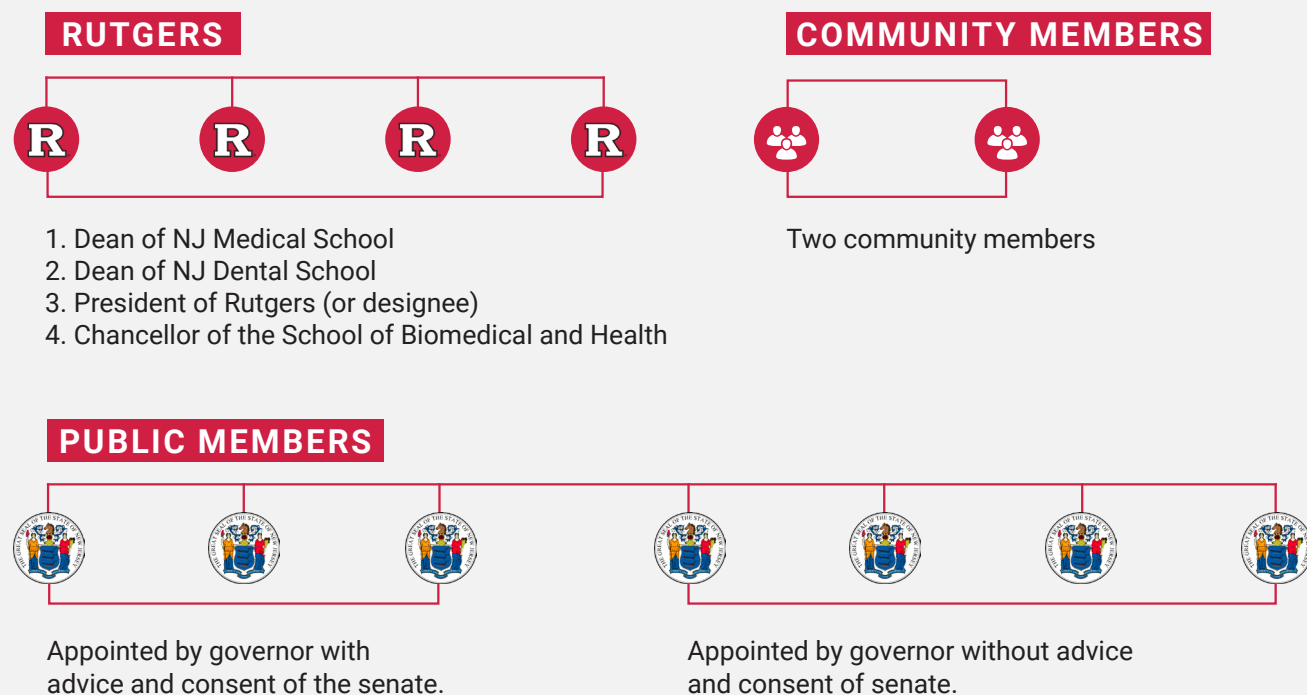


THE NEED TO ACT

ABOUT UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

One of only three Level 1 Trauma Centers in the state and is the state's only public acute care hospital which services the majority of the state's charity care patients. It is also the state's premiere teaching hospital.

 **Largest supplier of care for uninsured patients in the state.**

 **Each year, University Hospital serves upwards of 17,000 inpatients and 250,000 outpatients in its campus-based clinics each year. In 2018, the Emergency Room alone served nearly 94,000 patients.**

 **Nearly 39% of its patient base is insured by Medicaid.**
